

VOCALOID

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Vocaloid is the singing speech synthesis technology that was released through Yamaha. The product license also says that the product is a derived technology. It was developed in 2000 by a joint research project led by Kenmochi Hideki. It is a type of software that was created by the recording of human voices and can create a song by the user adding the words and melody. The first VOCALOID product was released in 2004.

Vocaloid has a number of characters played by special actors. Some of the famous characters are "Hatsune Miku", "Lin Ren", "Meiko," "Kite," "Luke," "GAKUPO" "GUMI". Many overseas voices and characters have also been entered.

Songs are of the genre called Vocaloid. Vocaloid music is now made by various people using "MusicStation" and "Kohaku Uta Gassen". It has also been broadcast on the radio. Although there are a variety of songs to listen to. One of the songs that I have heard was "Thousand Sakura". It is the most famous song in Japan.

Vocaloid users mainly post on the site called "Nico Nico Douga". The ranking of this site is constantly changing, but has been posting a lot of songs. In addition to Vocaloid, there are a lot of things that are technologically derived from real actors and singers. Dancing, singing and game play is mainstream, but there are also novels, and comic interpretation of other songs also.

Although many people post popular music, songs of famous people and characters have also been released as a CD. Vocaloid, and its users, sell not only their software and songs but also a variety of goods such as costumes, books, clear files, key ring and others are also sold.
